SUBJECT: NOTICE OF FINAL RULEMAKING, AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 6, INCREASING DAILY PARKING FEE FOR STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF WITH UNIVERSITY ISSUED IDENTIFICATION

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the University of the District of Columbia (the “University”) pursuant to the authority set forth under the District of Columbia Public Postsecondary Education Reorganization Act Amendments (Act) effective January 2, 1976 (D.C. Law 1-36; D.C. Official Code §§ 38-1202.01(a); 38-1202.06 (2001 & 2011 Supp.) sets the daily parking rate for the University’s parking garage.

WHEREAS, the University has been charging the existing daily parking garage rate for current students, faculty, and staff with active University issued identification for the previous six (6) years without an increase to the rate;

WHEREAS, the University seeks to avoid sporadic, significant daily parking garage rate increases while reflecting the current market rate of maintaining a parking garage by implementing an incremental daily parking garage rate increase for current students, faculty, and staff with University issued identification;

WHEREAS, the substance of the proposed rule enacted herein was published on October 27, 2017 at 64 DCR 011202 for a thirty-day public comment period in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-505(a); and no public comment was received during the public comment period; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 8B D.C.M.R. §128.4, where no comments are received, the Chairperson of the committee may forward the rules for final adoption without committee action;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia hereby amends Chapter 8 of the University Rules (Title 8-B6 DCMR) to increase the daily parking garage rate for current students, faculty, and staff for students, faculty, and staff with active University issued identification as indicated in the Notice of Final Rulemaking attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rules enacted herein shall take effect upon publication in the D.C. Register and that all prior inconsistent resolutions, customs, procedures, and practices are hereby repealed.

NOTICE OF FINAL RULEMAKING

The Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia pursuant to the authority set forth under the District of Columbia Public Postsecondary Education Reorganization Act Amendments (Act) effective January 2, 1976 (D.C. Law 1-36; D.C. Official Code §§ 38-1202.01(a); 38-1202.06)(3),(13) (2001 & 2011 Supp.) hereby amends chapter 6 (Campus Life) of subtitle B (University of the District of Columbia) of title 8 (Higher Education) of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) as follows to take effect upon publication of this notice in the *D.C. Register*.

The purpose of the final rulemaking is to increase daily parking rates for current students, faculty, and staff with active University issued identification beginning in the fall semester of 2017.

The substance of the final rule enacted herein was published on October 27, 2017 at 64 DCR 011202 for a thirty-day public comment period in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-505(a). No public comment was received during the public comment period. The rule was adopted by the Board as final on November 28, 2017, and will become effective upon publication of this notice in the *D.C. Register*.

Chapter 6, CAMPUS LIFE, of subtitle B, UNIVERSITY OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, of title 8, HIGHER EDUCATION, is amended as follows:

Section 607, PARKING FEES, Subsection 607.4 is amended as follows:

607.4 The daily parking fee for students, Faculty, and Staff with active University issued identification shall be four dollars (\$4.00) per day, except as otherwise provided in this chapter.

SUBJECT: Notice of Final Rulemaking – Parking Rate Increase

DATE: November 28, 2017

On September 19, 2017, the Board of Trustees approved a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) to increase the daily parking rates for current students, faculty, and staff with active University issued identification. The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking was published in the D.C. Register on October 27, 2017 for a thirty (30) day comment period. There have been no comments submitted as of November 22, 2017.

The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking was initially adopted and forwarded for consideration by the Operations Committee and the Academic and Student Affairs Committee. Pursuant to 8-B D.C.M.R. §128.4, if no public comments are received on a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, “the chairperson of the Board committee may forward the rules to the Board for final adoption without a meeting of or action by the committee.” Accordingly, we are requesting that each of you, as Chairperson of the Operations Committee and Academic and Student Affairs Committee, respectively, forward the referenced rulemaking action to the full Board of Trustees for its further consideration and final rulemaking action at the Board Meeting on November 28, 2017.¹ Please contact us if we can be of further assistance.

SUBJECT: Daily Discount Parking Rate

Conclusion

It has been concluded that the establishment of an increase in the daily “discount” parking rate for Auxiliary Services will result in a positive fiscal impact on the University of the District of Columbia’s annual revenue stream.

Background

The proposed resolution will establish an increase in the daily “discount” parking rate from \$3.50 to \$4.00 for UDC staff, students, and faculty. The proposed new daily rate would accomplish the following: (1) eliminate the surcharge the university is charged on the collection and reconciliation of coins; (2) generate a slight increase in revenue; and (3) allow the university to remain well below the market rate average for the Van Ness Corridor.

The new daily “discount” parking rate is projected to generate approximately \$17,346.00 in additional annual post-secondary revenue. The new daily “discount” parking rate will apply only to UDC staff, students, and faculty.

Financial Impact

It is projected that the proposed new daily “discount” parking rate would lead to an increase in revenue for the university. This request has been approved based on information provided.

There are no anticipated risks at this time.
