At their March 2018 meeting, the directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) reviewed the Visiting Team Report (VTR) for the University of the District of Columbia.

On behalf of the Board, it gives me great pleasure to inform you that the **Master of Architecture** degree program was granted a three-year term of initial accreditation. The term is effective January 1, 2017 and the program is scheduled for its first visit for continuation of accreditation in 2020.

Please be reminded that continuing accreditation is predicated on the following requirements:

- a) Annual Statistical Reports. These reports capture statistical information on the institution and the program. The next statistical report is due on or before November 30, 2018.
- b) Public dissemination of both the Architecture Program Report and the VTR is a condition of accreditation. These documents must be made public electronically in their entirety. Please see Condition II.4.4 of the *2014 Conditions for Accreditation* and Section 5 of the *NAAB Procedures for Accreditation, 2015 Edition*.
