URBAN AGRICULTURE

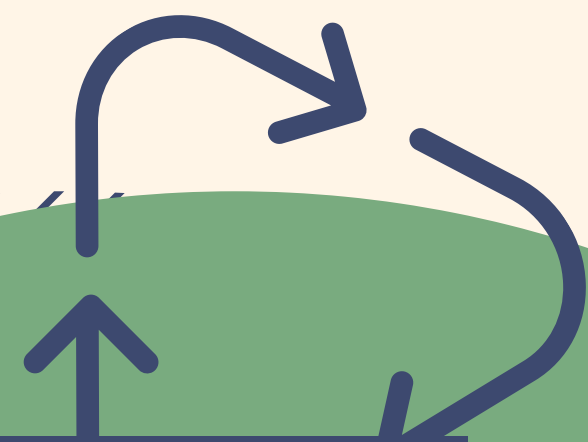
- UDC's rooftop garden provides fresh produce and absorbs rainwater.
- The UDC Food Truck is not only a mobile space for nutritional education, but facilitates access to healthy food choices.



- UDC's Aquaponics System is expected to produce 500 pounds of fish and 5,000 pounds of vegetables annually.
- Stormwater Collection Cisterns on campus collect runoff water for on-site recycling.
- There are 24 Brita Hydration Stations in 8 buildings, providing a free alternative to water bottles.
