FINDINGS:

1. Authorization:

D.C. Code § 2-354.04 (a); 8 DCMR Chapter 30, Section 3019, 3019.1, 3019.4 and 3019.5.

2. Minimum Need:

The University of the District of Columbia (UDC), Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Division of Allied Health, Life and Physical Science has an immediate need to purchase a microscope

3. Estimated Cost:

The estimated cost \$23,091.24 has been deemed fair and reason through the vendor's published price listing.

4. Facts Which Justify Sole Source Procurement:

- a) Pursuant to DC Code 2-354.04 (a) and 8 DCMR Chapter 30, Section 3019, a contract may be awarded through noncompetitive negotiations when there is only one source for the required good or service.
 - **Olympus America, Inc.**, is the only authorized supplier for Olympus Biological microscopes in the Washington, DC area. Purchasing this product from any other source will not carry the Olympus Warranty Guaranteed or service.
- b) It is in the best interests of the University to meet its requirements through procurement of the CX23 Biological Microscope from **Olympus America**, Inc., and the proposed contractor.
