The UDC National Alumni Society announces Mah-ki M. Fox as new President

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The University of the District of Columbia National Alumni Society (UDCNAS) Board of Directors announces that Mr. Mah-ki M. Fox will become its National President and head of its Board of Directors effective Tuesday, January 19, 2016. After serving since April 2015, President James D. Gaston III decided to vacate the lead role to allow him more time with his family and new professional pursuits. Gaston has been a steady guide during his time as UDCNAS President, increasing visibility, alumni engagement and communications. Due to the vacancy, Fox will transition from the position of First Vice President to replace Gaston.

Prior to becoming First Vice President, Fox also served as Fundraising Chair for UDCNAS and raised an estimated \$18,000 in memberships, donations, grants and partnerships between 2013 and 2014. He also chaired several major initiatives including the 2015 UDCNAS Members Retreat and the 2015 UDCNAS Awards Dinner.

Fox completed his Bachelor of Business Administration degree at the University of the District of Columbia (2007), and both his Masters in Management (2010) and Masters in Business Administration (2012) at the University of Maryland University College. He has served in multiple positions in public and private industry including as an Associate Project Manager at Booz Allen Hamilton, a management and technology consulting firm. Fox was recruited by the American Marketing Association (AMA) to be a 2014 contributor for both of its international publications and as a conference speaker for its “Marketers in Business” conference. Fox is currently the CEO and Managing Director of ISTJ Consulting, headquartered in Washington, D.C.
