The University of the District of Columbia (UDC) is a public land grant institution in the District of Columbia. The Counseling department consists of:

- MS in Counseling School Concentration (60 semester hours): Accredited under the 2009 CACREP Standards
- ➤ MA in Rehabilitation Counseling (60 semester hours): Accredited under the 2016 CACREP Standards
- MS in Counseling Mental Health Concentration (60 semester hours): under CACREP review

The CACREP national accreditation for both the MS in Counseling – School Concentration and MA in Rehabilitation Counseling programs extends to March and October 2024 respectively. This report of vital statistics is required of all CACREP-accredited programs and must be publicly reported in a program outcomes report for the program website.

Current students enrolled in the 2 1/2-year program= 40 matriculated in both the Rehabilitation Counseling and School Counseling Programs

Graduates from program in 2021-2022=16

Completion rate of students in program =87% (% of admitted students who graduate from the program in the expected time (full and part-time student in 3-5yrs)

Licensure examination pass rate of students graduating from program=N/A

Students completing the program must complete 2000-hour post Masters in two-years before sitting for exam. Job Placement rate of graduates seeking employment= 100%

100% of 2021-2022 MS graduates reported that if they were seeking employment in mental health post-graduation, they are working in mental health locations. Eighty percent of interns continued as employees at their sites after graduation or offered employment.
