UDC is composed of six colleges and schools, plus a workforce development unit, that anchor its academic and community impact:

- College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) offers rigorous programs in education, social work, biology, homeland security, the arts, and more—fields that directly address the District's workforce and community needs.
- College of Agriculture, Urban Sustainability and Environmental Sciences (CAUSES) focuses on health equity, nutrition, climate resiliency, and sustainable urban systems, preparing students to solve the most pressing challenges facing cities.

- School of Business and Public Administration (SBPA) is AACSB-accredited, placing it among the top 5% of business schools globally. Its programs in finance, management, and procurement prepare graduates for leadership roles in government and industry.
- School of Engineering and Applied Sciences (SEAS) trains the next generation of innovators in fields like computer science, cybersecurity, biomedical engineering, and nanotechnology, offering ABET-accredited programs that open doors to high-demand careers.
- UDC Community College (UDC-CC) delivers associate degrees and certificate programs that connect learners to immediate employment, particularly in high-need fields like healthcare, early childhood education, aviation maintenance and quantum information technology.
- UDC David A. Clarke School of Law (UDC-DACSL) boasts the most robust clinical legal education program in the country, with every student providing hundreds of hours of free legal services across the District.
- Workforce Development and Lifelong Learning (WDLL) delivers free programs designed to rapidly upskill DC residents and prepare them for in-demand careers. WDLL reaches thousands of learners annually through flexible offerings in hospitality, construction, technology, and healthcare support. These programs are central to UDC's mission to create economic mobility and meet the talent needs in the region's labor market.

UDC returns \$4 to the city for every \$1 of public investment. Our alumni work in education, government, healthcare, law, engineering and infrastructure, technology and agriculture—fields vital to the District's future.
