Dear Firebirds,

Here is additional guidance on returning to the campuses in Fall 2021. It is based on currently available information from several sources, including a university-wide survey, District and federal guidance.

- All facilities will be open to the limit of government allowed capacity
- Full vaccination will be required for access to all facilities
- Masks will be required when on the campuses
- Social distancing will be required
- Learning will be delivered through a combination of face-to-face, virtual/remote, hybrid, and limited HYFLEX modalities
- Employees will report to work on the campuses based on schedules and exceptions approved by the respective Cabinet member
- Tuition and fees will remain at their current levels for the 2021-2022 academic year
- Parking permits will be issued for the fall with optional reserve parking

Vaccination sites are available near campus, including a walkup facility operated by DC Health at 4225 Connecticut NW (across the street from the Student Center) that is expected to open early May.

We continue to develop the details of the plan outlined above and will provide updates as information becomes available. Our primary consideration is the health and safety of our UDC family. Please check your email and visit the “myUDC” portal regularly for updates.
