C.15 <u>CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE QUALIFICATIONS:</u> The following minimum qualifications are required for each of the labor categories required on the contract.

C.15.1

<u>Project Manager:</u> A senior executive with extensive experience in the real estate and Professional Services field organizing and managing large or medium building construction projects of similar complexity and magnitude. The candidates for this position shall be a registered professional (RA, PE, PMP, CMA).

C.15.2

<u>Project Manager Junior:</u> Professional Engineer in Training, Architect or Construction Manager with experience in organizing and managing large or medium building construction projects of similar complexity and magnitude.

C.15.3

<u>Construction Manager:</u> Qualified professional in this field with related experience in large or medium building construction projects of similar complexity and magnitude. Responsible for coordinating daily construction operations, and provides regular status and incident reports. The candidates for this position shall be a registered professional (RA, PE, PMP, CMA).

C.15.4

<u>Sr. Cost Estimator:</u> Qualified certified professional in this field with related experience in large or medium building construction projects of similar complexity and magnitude.

C.15.5

<u>M/E/P Inspector:</u> Qualified professional in this field with extensive related experience in large or medium building construction projects of similar complexity and magnitude

C.16 GOVERNMENT RECORDS

The Contractor shall not disclose any information or data to anyone unless approved by the District. All such information or data is reserved exclusively for use between the University and the Contractor, including employees of the Contractor's firm. When deemed appropriate, the University may authorize the release of certain information or data necessary for use by the Contractor in performance of contract work, and in such cases specific written authorization must be obtained from CO in advance. Such data so released shall not be further disseminated and shall not be considered released into the public domain. The Contractor must ensure that this clause is included in all tiers of subcontracts.

ATTACHMENT C

G.9 ORDERING LIMITATIONS

G.9.1 MINIMUM ORDER:

The University guarantees the minimum order limitation to the Contractor in the amount of \$250.00 per year on the contract.

G.9.2 MAXIMUM ORDER:

There will be a maximum of \$950,000.00 per year on the contract. The University may issue any number of TOs, in any amount, the cumulative total of which cannot exceed \$950,000.00.

G.9.3 TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT:

The total amount for 5 (5) years shall not exceed \$4,750,000.00.

G.10 TASK ORDERING PROCEDURES

G.10.1 Ordering:

Any services to be performed under this contract shall be based on fixed price TO(s) issued in writing and signed by the CO. All TOs are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. In the event of conflict between a TO and this contract, the contract shall control.

G.10.2

As the need exists for performance under the terms of this contract, the CO shall notify the contractor of an existing requirement via the issuance of a RFP. The RFP will detail the project scope.

G.10.3

If the University feels that the price submitted by the Contractor for the RFP is not reasonable, the University will negotiate the price and then issue a TO to the Contractor.

G.10.4

Upon receipt and acceptance of the TO, the Contractor shall take necessary action to comply with the requirements and the period of performance stated in the TO.

G.10.4.1

Each TO shall include the following information:

- (1) Specific scope of requirement inclusive of all tasks and deliverables
- (2) Date of the TO
- (3) Contract number and TO number
- (4) Number of hours in each labor category with unit price
- (5) TO performance period or delivery schedule
- (6) TO administrator or point of contact if different from the CA
- (7) Place of performance

G.10.4.2

The CA shall be responsible for the daily administration of the TOs and the performance of the Contractor.

G.11 TASK ORDER COMPETITION

Under this Contract, the University shall offer Professional Services for various construction projects to IDIQ Contractors. It is the University's intention that all IDIQ Contactors shall have an opportunity to provide services to the University. Each successive RFP the University issues will specify the basis for
