ADD SECTION C.5 PORTER SERVICE AS FOLLOWS:

C.5 PORTER SERVICE

The Contractor will provide four (4) porters during business hours (Monday through Friday 8am – 5pm) excluding recognized holidays. A replacement is required with absence or scheduled time off for assigned staff. Porters will perform specific required services. Porters will provide services for all University facilities and campuses as required by the CA. As Specified, porters may perform the following tasks but not be limited to:

- 1. Remove and arrange office and classroom furniture, equipment and appliances, move heavy pieces of equipment and machinery when assigned.
- 2. Assist in assembly and disassembly of furniture, furnishings, etc.
- 3. The Contractor shall provide the University's Contract Administrator with a daily roster of all porters available.
- 4. Perform warehouse duties such as palletizing material, loading and unloading trucks, labeling items/property etc.
- 5. Assist maintenance personnel with special projects.
- 6. Porters shall not perform daily basic cleaning services to substitute for the absence of cleaning personnel.
- 7. Perform conference style set-ups for university functions. Arrangement of table, chairs, podiums, and other items used in group gatherings.
