Bylaws

This committee shall: (1) Review campus and system-wide research policies and issues related to the campus research mission; (2) Establish procedures to facilitate communication between those doing research and those who guide, fund, and administer research projects; (3) Facilitate regularly scheduled research seminars to provide interaction between the funding organizations and the university researchers; (4) Compile faculty publications in a database for easy retrieval and distribution; (5) Represent faculty research interests individually and/or collectively and be responsive to questions and concerns of both faculty and student researchers; (6) and Encourage and support University faculty in their scholarly endeavors.

Achievements and Initiatives

- The committee reviewed the existing bylaws. We had no changes to submit.
- The committee developed a project plan to create a Faculty Research Index as a joint initiative
 with the Library. The project plan was approved by the Faculty Senate in December 2021. The
 committee began executing the steps of the plan and created a submission form and website.
 The Library began initial outreach and data collection in May 2022. The project was transferred
 to the Library for on-going development.
- The committee met with Dr. Cherie Ann Turpin. The presentation allowed us to discuss ways RAD could encompass the diversity, equity, and inclusion initiatives within our work.
- The committee met with Dr. Victor McCrary in March 2022. We discussed ways our committee
 and the Office of Sponsored Programs can work together to support faculty research at the
 University
- The committee facilitated the creation of an Ad Hoc committee to liaise with administration regarding the external funding moratorium.

Carry Over Items

The Faculty Research Index will be an on-going data collection and processing project. This is a
joint initiative with the Library. Meghan Kowalski, Outreach and Reference Librarian, will handle
the faculty outreach, data entry, and Index updates going forward. She will report back to the
committee by request.

 - iv. Asking what is needed for the research and work of minoritized groups (more emphasis of funding in areas of women, transgender, queer, etc. projects)
 - v. Brainstorming Ideas
 - 1. Adding pronouns to faculty research index
 - 2. Having students/faculty help build content/events that promote these areas of research (Inviting more voices and opportunities to the table.)
 - 3. Encouraging students to come back to UDC to join the discussion

- 4. Finding ways to encourage/fund more research in these areas (good not just for our students/faculty but also for UDC and the community as a whole)
- 5. Creating more virtual tools (i.e. Zoom, twitter, etc.) to share and promote more minoritized voices (ex. Webinar series promoting research being done by or about minoritized groups)
- 6. Diversity and Inclusion in Research and Learning Statement (adopted at the University level) crafted in such a way as to not tokenize
- 7. Creating a UDC newspaper/newsletter that is independent of the University but about the UDC community (to share student and faculty news)

- 3. How can RAD help? Encourage faculty to participate in UDC Research Week; How can the faculty work and get outside of UDC to share what we do as a comprehensive research University; Goal to be R2 by 2024 (across all domains, not just STEM); Collect more research stories to share with OSP wants to meet with more programs; List of research capabilities and subject matter experts; Get NSF biosketches of everyone; Setting up regular meetings with Dr. McCrary to touch base more frequently; Helping get more data about how we are doing for a research point of view; How do we mentor faculty members?; Advocate for more staff at OSP; Not looking to become R1; Added that faculty should not hesitate to contact him about anything related to research and funding
